
Obituaries

In keeping with the theme of their professional careers in Food Science, Jim & Ericka shared the belief that meals are the cornerstone of a strong family and the key to healthy children, so they insisted on one rule: everyone must gather for dinner every night. And no matter how late or disorganized, Jim and Ericka were sure to have food on the table and children in their seats, which more often than not included the many visiting friends of their daughters.

As the children grew and matured, so did their palates and the family meals began to veer away from the usual requests for hot dogs, cheese puffs and flakey flix. Jim and Ericka soon realized they had quite a large collection of gourmet recipes and a new hobby was created: 'The Fumblesome Fambly Cookbook.' Over the years, they happily crafted several versions of their cookbook; a collection of family favorites, old & new.

When Jim retired from UCD, they switched directions and started pursuing a new hobby and dream: Building the family farm up in Humboldt County. Over the next few years, they built a beautiful main house and a guest cottage, complete with a huge workshop. They terraced a large portion of the property and planted a cherry orchard and an enormous kitchen garden, which included fruit trees, vegetables, herbs & flowers. When Ericka retired, they moved up to the farm permanently and happily hosted many gatherings over the years for family and friends. Always with amazing meals, great wines and exhilarating laughter.
