

Davis Professor Gets \$1,000 Dairy Award

DAVIS, Yolo Co.—The 1957 Borden award in dairy manufacturing has been won by University of California dairy scientist Nikita P. Tarassuk, professor of dairy industry on the Davis campus. He received a gold medal and \$1,000 in recognition of his research in the chemistry of milk.

The award was presented to Tarassuk at the 52nd annual meeting of the American Dairy Science Association at Oklahoma State University in Stillwater.
